 - o Some rules:
 - Make sure that your name is NOT on any of the items

 - Be sure NOT to bring in any valuable items (since your classmates will be handling it)

In Class:

Task: Take 2 bags per partnership (if you get your own, put it back and get a new one). Use the items inside to develop a story to tell your partner.

- Analyze the items in your bag
- Put items in a sequential order that would you allow you to develop a biography of your classmate
- Take time to develop the story
 - o Must incorporate all items and have at least several sentences per item
- Each partner presents their story to each other
- Share with whole class
