- Section #3 Read a passage from a story written by a student, which contains some mistakes in grammar and spelling. Then, complete 5 multiple choice questions about revising and editing the passage for modal auxiliaries and homophones.
- **Section #4** Refer back to BOTH passages to write a <u>short response</u> to a prompt about how the **narrative point of view makes the passages different**.

There will be **one section** to the test today, in which you will have to:

• Section #1 - Refer back to one of the passages and write a <u>narrative story</u> in which you retell an event from the point of view of one of the characters.

## Key concepts/skills to know are:

- Identifying the **point of view** from which a story is told (Who is the narrator?)
- Referring to <u>details and examples</u> in a text when **explaining what the text says** and when <u>drawing inferences</u> from the text
- Describing a character referring to <u>specific details</u> in the text (What does a character's thoughts, words, or actions tell you about them?)
- Determining the meaning of words and phrases as they are used in a text (ex. metaphor)
- Summarizing the text by choosing key events and putting them in order
- Word Study: Compound Words and Vowel-Consonant-e Syllable Patterns
- Grammar: Modal Auxiliaries and Homophones (frequently confused words)
